MusiCamp Theme:

Psalms & Psongs—Scripture songs from Psalms

Who May Participate:

There are **TWO** levels for MusiCamp: Elementary (grades 1-5), and Middle School (grades 6-8).

CAMPER REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

MusiCamp is for all boys and girls who have **completed grades 1-8 and are at least 6 years old.**

Complete a registration form by **Wednesday, July 11** in order to register for MusiCamp. Forms must be postmarked by July 11 or be received in the church office before 5PM on July 11. Registration is not complete until tuition is paid in full.

Camper Tuition:

Tuition includes camp t-shirt, lunch each day, admission to Splash Kingdom Water Park on Wednesday afternoon, music CD, and camp supplies.



Regular tuition: \$89 per person by Wednesday, July 11

Early tuition: \$79 per person by Wednesday, June 20

Returning Camper: \$75 per person by Wednesday, June 20

(MUST have attended MusiCamp 2017 to be eligible for this discounted tuition rate)

Registration must include payment to be considered complete.

Limited MusiCamp Scholarships are available—contact the church office for more information

Camper Activities Include:

Choir rehearsals, choreography sessions, Bible Study and small group activities, music theory class, and specialty classes. Specialty Classes may include: Drama, Hand Chimes, Sign Language, Recorders, Interpretive Movement, and Rockin' Rhythms. Campers will memorize an entire musical, which they will present on Friday evening as part of the camp concert.



Drama | Solo | Instrumental Ensemble Auditions:



Campers who wish to audition for a drama part and/or a music solo or to be a part of the Instrumental Ensemble **MUST** attend the MusiCamp auditions on **Sunday, July 15 between 3-5PM**. Drama roles are open only to those who have completed grades 4-8; solos are open to any camper who may wish to audition; instrumental ensemble is open to Middle School campers only. **Detailed audition information will be mailed** to each camper after they register for camp. Please note: not all campers who audition will be selected for a drama role and/or solo or placed in the instrumental ensemble.

Camp Lunch:



A different full lunch, including green salad, fruit and drinks, will be served each day and is part of the camp tuition fee. Lunch examples include: pizza, hamburgers, and chicken nuggets. **Important:** be sure to list on the registration form any food allergies your camper may have so we can have options available.

FUN Camp Outing:

All campers will participate in the **Wednesday afternoon outing to Splash Kingdom Water Park**. Camp will conclude at **6PM** that day. Campers will be transported from the church to the water park. Parents will pick up campers at the water park at 6PM. If a camper has a season pass to Splash Kingdom, a reduction of \$12 from the camp tuition fee may be taken. Campers who do not wish to participate in the outing must indicate that on the registration form and may deduct \$12 from the tuition fee.



Camp Concert:



All campers are expected to participate in the camp concert Friday evening, July 27 at 7PM in Lakeshore's Sanctuary. The concert features presentations by some of the specialty classes and the camp musical with drama and solos. Campers will wear their camp t-shirt and long blue jeans or slacks.

MIDDLE SCHOOL CAMPER INFORMATION:

NEW THIS YEAR: Middle School MusiCamp (grades 6-8) will run concurrently with the Elementary MusiCamp (no LIT camp this year.) There will be some camp-wide combined sessions, but most classes will not mix ages and there will be some classes which will be open to middle school campers only. Campers will participate in class sessions, lunch, fun outing and the camp concert. Campers will also get a similar MusiCamp t-shirt. Tuition deadlines and registration form & information is the same as the Elementary camp.



CAMP LEADER INFORMATION:



All adults and older youth (those who have completed grade 9 and are at least 15 years old) who wish to be a class teacher, group leader, class assistant, or kitchen helper must complete a worker application to be considered for a leadership position in MusiCamp. Please contact the camp director or the church office for a worker application. Leader applications are also available on-line through the church website. Camp will be staffed according to classes offered and availability of leaders. Adult and youth workers are selected based on prior experience, both at MusiCamp and other camps, and open staffing positions. Adults will take priority over youth. Youth who have been previous leaders and/or who were former campers or LIT campers will receive priority over other youth. All worker applications must be received in the church office by **2PM on Friday, June 29**. Applicants will be contacted during the week of July 9. There is no cost for adult and older youth leaders.
