Additionally, our nursery provides a loving, safe, and biblical environment, so that parents feel confident in leaving their child in our care.

Childcare Worker Requirements:

- Complete Ministry Safe Training, CPR and first aid training, and submit to a background check.
- Create a clean and nurturing environment where children can learn.
- Cultivate positive relationships with families, children, and other staff.
- Teach age-appropriate Bible curriculum during the Bible study hour.
- Provide consistent structure/routines in the classroom.
- Provide an attentive and safe environment for children to play.

Skills and Experience:

- CPR and First Aid Certification or willingness to obtain
- Complete Ministry Safe Training
- Must be able to pass a background check
- Must be able to lift a minimum of 40 pounds and work indoors and outdoors
- Must be able to assume postures in low levels to allow physical and visual contact with children, see and hear well enough to keep children safe, and engage in physical activity with children
